Since 2004, our goal has been simple: create Hopi language learning materials that help our children, families, and communities keep Hopi strong.

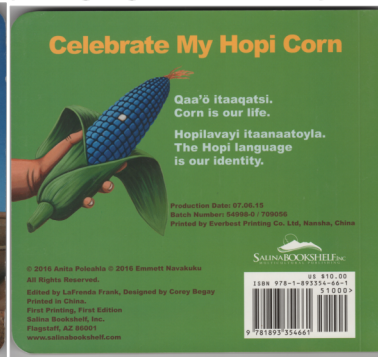
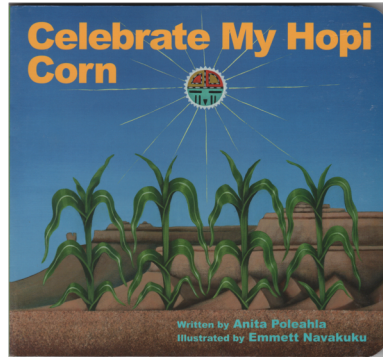

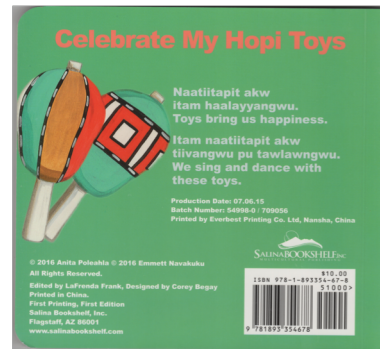
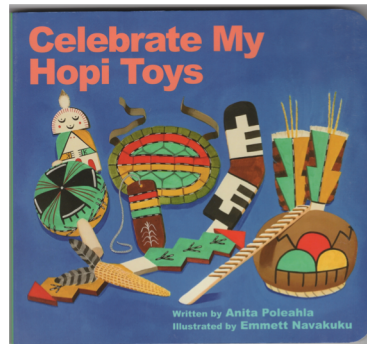
Corn is our life. The Hopi language is our identity

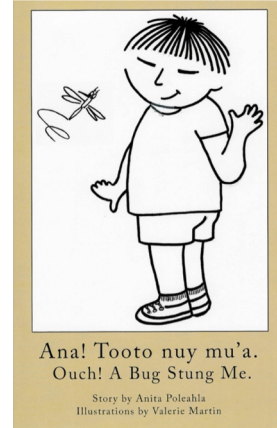

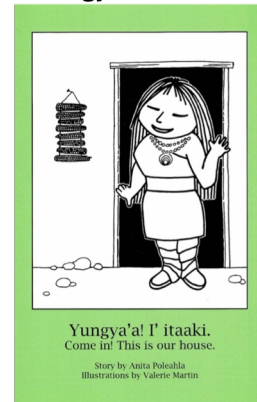

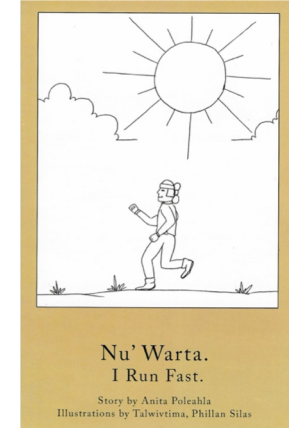
Ouch! Is a wonderful introduction to Hopi postpositions and movement words.

Oops! A fun story that introduces everyday actions, emotions, and problem-solving vocabulary.

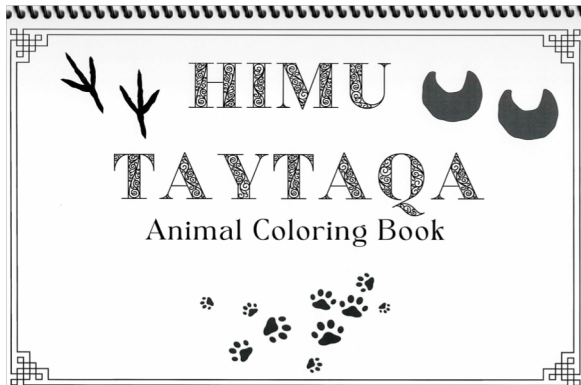

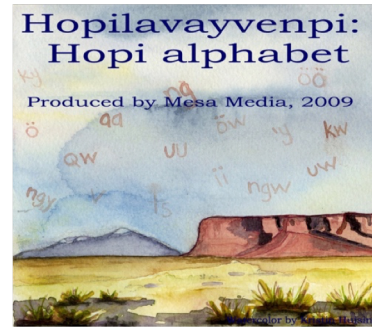

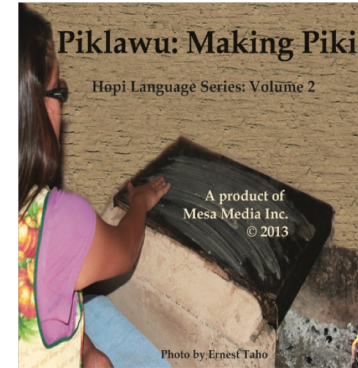

Piklawu



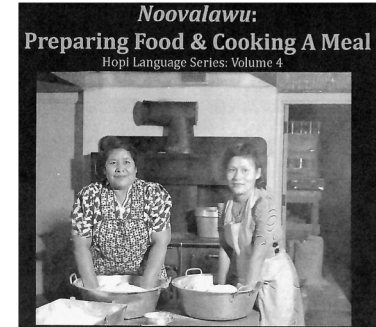
